Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Having Current Rabies Vaccinations for the Dogs That Are Housed at the Facility. At the Time of the Inspection, One of the 3 Dogs Housed at the Facility Had Expired Rabies Vaccinations. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance. (1), The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Exceeding the Maximum Group Sizes Listed in Table 2 with 2 Caregivers. At the Time of the Inspection, There Were 3 Visiting Neighborhood Children That Were at the Facility. (1), and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Having the Number of Children in Care Exceed the Capacity of the Facility. At the Time of the Inspection, There Were 25 Children in the Facility Making the Facility Over Capacity by 6 Children. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
