This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance as Noted on 03/10/2025, 12/03/2024, 10/18/2023, & 09/15/2022 (3), The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-6(1) by Not Completing 20 Hours of Child Care Training Each Year, Based on the Facility's License Date. At the Time of Renewal, the Annual Training Hours Had Not Been Completed. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance as Noted on 04/12/2023. (1), and The Licensee Was Out of Compliance Wit R430-90-15(1)(a)-(f) by Not Keeping the Facility Free of Animal Feces. In the Outdoor Area, There Was a Build-up of Dog Feces. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance as Noted on 12/03/2024, & 10/18/2023. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
