Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were The Provider Was Out of Compliance with Rule R381-100-7(9)(c) by Not Ensuring That Caregivers Complete the Preservice Training Offered by the Department Before Caring for Children. During the Inspection, There Were Two Caregivers Who Had Not Completed Preservice Training and Were Caring for Children (1) and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with Rule R381-100-6(10) by Not Ensuring That a Child Had a Completed Admission and Health Assessment Form Before Being Admitted Into the Program. At the Facility, a Child Did Not Have a Completed Health Assessment Form. (1). None of the 2 findings were critical.
