Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Having Empty Plastic Bags Accessible to Children Younger Than Five Years Old. In an Accessible Kitchen Drawer, There Was an Empty Plastic Grocery Bag and an Empty Garbage Bag. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance. (2) and The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-19(13) by Having Strangulation Hazards on Stationary Play Equipment. In the Outdoor Area, There Was a 16 Inch Rope Tied Around a Trampoline. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.

Feb 21, 2024 1 Finding ● 1 Important

- The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Having Electrical Outlets Without Protective Caps or Safety Devices When Not in Use. In the Upstairs Nap Room Where a Child Was Napping, There Was One Outlet Without Protective Covers. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance.
