Across 4 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R380-600-7(16)(a) by Not Reporting a Critical Incident to the Office Within One Business Day. During Review of Critical Incidents It Was Identified That the Incident Occurred on 06/24/2025 and Was Not Reported Until 06/26/2025. (1), The Provider Was Out of Compliance with Rule R381-100-13(9)(a)-(d) by Not Ensuring That Hazardous Chemicals Were Inaccessible to Children. In the Lobby of the Facility, There Was a Bottle of Dish Soap and Water and a Container of Bleach Wipes, Both on a Desk, Accessible to Children. This Was a Rep (1), and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with Rule R381-100-9(19) by Not Ensuring That There Were No Gaps Greater Than 5 Inches by 5 Inches Under a Barrier or Fence. On the 3 and Older Playground, There Was a Gap Under the Fence That Was Greater Than 5 Inches by 5 Inches. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
