● 3 Important

Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-10(3) by Not Ensuring That There Were at Least Two Caregivers When There Were More Than Three Children Younger Than Two Years of Age. At the Time of the Inspection, There Was One Caregiver and Five Children Under Two Years of Age. (1), The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-24(15) by Not Ensuring Infants Sleep in Equipment Designed for Sleep. At the Time of the Inspection, There Was an Infant Sleeping in an Inclined Sleeper That Was Not Designed for Infant Sleep. (1), and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Having a Gap Five by Five Inches or Greater in or Under the Fence or Barrier. In the Outdoor Area, There Were Gaps at the Bottom of the Fence That Were Greater Than Five by Five Inches in Diameter. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
