(3) and The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-13(3) by Having Sharp Objects Accessible to Children. In the Outdoor Play Area, There Was Broken Glass. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance as Noted On: 7/11/2023. (2). None of the 5 findings were critical.
