Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Having Strangulation Hazards on or Within the Use Zone of Any Piece of Stationary Play Equipment. In the Outdoor Play Area, Each of the Handgrips on the Rock Climbing Wall Were Loose. (2), The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Having Choking Hazards Accessible to Children Younger Than Three Years Old. In the Kitchen, There Were Small Plastic Pieces Accessible in a Drawer and in the Outdoor Play Area, There Was a Marker Lid on the Ground. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompli (2), and The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-8(3)(c) by Not Ensuring That a New Background Check Form and Fingerprints Are Submitted for a Covered Individual That Has Turned 18 Years Old. At the Time of Inspection, One Household Member Has Not Had Their Fingerprints Scanned. This Was a Repeat Rul (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
