Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Provider Was Out of Compliance with Rule R381-100-11(1)(c) by Not Ensuring That Each Caregiver Maintains Active Supervision of Each Child by Knowing the Number of Children in Their Care at Any Time. In School Age Room, the Caregiver Stated They Had 9 Children in Care When There Were 8 Children I (2), The Provider Was Out of Compliance with Rule R381-100-13(4) by Having Choking Hazards Accessible to Children Younger Than Three Years Old. In the 2s Classroom, There Were Choking Hazards Accessible to Children Younger Than Three Years Old. (1), and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Having Prepared Breast Milk Labeled Properly. In the Infant Room, There Were Prepared Bags of Breast Milk in the Fridge That Were Not Labeled with the Time of Preparation. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
