Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Ensuring That Caregivers Completed the 1-1/2 Hours of Preservice Training Offered by the Department Before Caring for Children. At the Time of the Inspection, There Were Two Caregivers Who Had Been Caring for Children Who Did Not Complete The (2), The Provider Was Out of Compliance with Rule R381-40-13(9)(b) by Not Ensuring That Toxic or Hazardous Chemicals Were Inaccessible to Any Child. In the Front Bathroom That the Children Use, There Was a Container of Bleach Wipes on the Back of the Toilet, Accessible to Children. This Was a Repeat Ule (1), and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Ensuring That if the Facility Had an Outdoor Area, That It Was Enclosed with a Fence That Had No Gaps Five by Five Inches or Greater in or Under It. On the Outdoor Playground, the Fence Had a Gap at the Bottom of It That Was Greater Than Five (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
