Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-13(4) by Having Choking Hazards Accessible to Children. In the Downstairs Living Room, in the Top Left Desk Drawer, There Were Small Chocolate Candy Accessible. (2) and The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-14(4) by Not Conducting Quarterly Fire Drills. During the Inspection, the Last Fire Drill Conducted Was in June of 2024. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.

- The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-14(4) by Not Conducting Quarterly Fire Drills. During the Inspection, the Last Fire Drill Conducted Was in June of 2024.
