Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-8(3)(a)-(c) by Not Ensuring That Covered Individuals Submit a New Background Form and Fingerprints When They Turn 18 Years Old. At the Time of Inspection, One Household Member Had Turned 18 Years Old and Submitted a New Background Form, but Had Not Sub (3), The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Conducting Fire Drills Quarterly. At the Time of Inspection, There Had Been Just One Fire Drill Conducted Since 2023. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance. (1), and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Having Hot Water That Exceeded 120 Degrees Fahrenheit Accessible to Children.
