At the Time of the Inspection, There Was One Cat Living at the Facility That Didn't Have Current Rabies Vaccinations. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance. (2) and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Having Required Paperwork. At the Time of the Inspection, Two Children Were Missing Their Admission and Health Assessment Forms. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
