Across 4 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were The Provider Was Out of Compliance with Rule R381-100-11(1)(e) by Not Ensuring That Caregivers Provided and Maintained Active Supervision of Each Child, Including the Caregivers Knowing the Number of Children in Their Care at Any Time. In the toddler/2's Room, the Caregiver Did Not Know the Number O (3) and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Ensuring That for Mixed-age Groups of Children That Included Infants or Toddlers, There Were at Least Two Caregivers in the Group if the Group Included a Younger Toddler with Older Toddlers and Two Year Olds. In the Toddler Room, There Was One (2). None of the 5 findings were critical.
