Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R381-100-11(1) by Failing to Ensure All Children Received Active Supervision. During an Investigation, It Was Determined That Two Children Engaged in Inappropriate, Sexual Play, While Two Caregivers Attended to Other Facility Tasks. (1) and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Ensuring That Choking Hazards Were Inaccessible to Children Younger Than Three Years Old. In the 2/3's Room, There Was a Small Plastic Letter on a Shelf, Accessible to Children Younger Than Three Years Old. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance (1). None of the 2 findings were critical.
