(1), The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with Rule R430-90-13(9)(a)-(d) by Having Accessible Toxic Chemicals. In the Downstairs Closet, There Was an Outdoor Bug Spray Agent Accessible in the Closet. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance as Noted on May 7, 2024. (1), and The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-6(9) by Not Having Required Forms for Each Child Enrolled. During the Inspection, One Child Did Not Have an Admission Form. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance as Noted on March 20, 2023. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
