Across 1 inspection since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Exceeding the Mixed-age Ratio of Older Toddlers and Older Children. In the Classroom, There Were 2 Toddlers Mixed with 7 Two-year-olds with One Caregiver. (1) and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Having Required Caregiver Training Completed. At the Time of the Inspection, One Caregiver Had Not Completed Pre-service Training Offered by the Department Before Beginning Caregiving Duties. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance. (1). None of the 2 findings were critical.
