(1) and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with Rule R381-100-24(20) by Having Loose Blankets in Sleeping Equipment While in Use by Sleeping Infants. In the Infants Classroom, There Was an Infant Sleeping with a Loose Blanket. (1). None of the 2 findings were critical.
