Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-13(9)(a)-(d) by Having Toxic or Hazardous Chemicals Accessible to Children. In the Back Playroom, There Was a Loose Battery Accessible. (3) and The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-6(11)(a) by Not Having Forms Updated. At the Time of the Inspection, There Were 5 Children's Forms That Were Not Updated, Reviewed, or Signed Since January 2024. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance as Noted on 9/25/2024 and 9/21/2022. (2). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-13(4) by Having Choking Hazards Accessible. In the Back Playroom, There Were Broken Pieces of Crayons and a Small Elastic Accessible.

- The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-13(9)(a)-(d) by Having Toxic or Hazardous Chemicals Accessible to Children. In the Back Playroom, There Was a Loose Battery Accessible.
