## 3 Inspection Visits Since 2025 - 5 Findings

● 5 Important

Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-19(9)(a)-(c) by Not Ensuring That Each Accessible Trampoline Had No Ladders or Other Objects Within the Use Zone a Child Could Use to Climb on the Trampoline. At the Time of Inspection, There Was a Ladder Propped Against the Trampoline. (2), The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-13(8) by Having Standing Water That Measured Two Inches or Deeper and Five by Five Inches or Greater in Diameter Accessible to Children. In the Outdoor Play Area, There Were 2 Five Gallon Buckets Filled with Water Under the Deck Stairs. (1), and The Licensee Was Out of Compliance for R430-90-7(4)(g) by Not Ensuring That Caregivers Complete at Least 20 Hours of Child Care Training Each Year. At the Time of Inspection, the Licensee Had Not Submitted Any Training. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-13(8) by Having Standing Water That Measured Two Inches or Deeper and Five by Five Inches or Greater in Diameter Accessible to Children. In the Outdoor Play Area, There Were 2 Five Gallon Buckets Filled with Water Under the Deck Stairs.**

● **The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-19(5) by Not Ensuring That Each Accessible Trampoline Without a Safety Net Enclosure Had at Least a Six-foot Use Zone. In the Outdoor Play Area, the Accessible Trampoline Had a Tree and a Fence Within the Use Zone.**
