Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Having a Hot Substance Accessible to Children in Care. In an Infant Classroom, a Child Accessed the Cord of a Bottle Warmer, and Pulled the Warmer and the Hot Water in It, Onto Their Body, Causing Burns. (2), The Provider Was Out of Compliance with Rule R381-100-14(4) by Not Conducting Fire Drills at Least Monthly. At the Time of the Inspection, a Fire Drill Was Not Completed in November 2024. (1), and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Maintaining an Environment That Protected the Children in Care. In an Infant Classroom, a Bottle Warmer Containing Hot Water Was Accessible to a Child, Who Pulled on the Warmer and Was Burned by the Liquid It Contained. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
