In the toddler/2's Room, There Was a Lunch Bag on a Shelf with the Other Lunch Bags That Had Been Brought From Home by Parents Fo (2) and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Ensuring That the Caregiver-to-child Ratio Was Doubled Only if the Children in the Group Were at Least 18 Months Old. In the toddler-3's Room, the Provider Was Over the Naptime Ratio Since Two of the Children Were Not at Least 18 Months Old. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
