(3) and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Submitting Background Check for a Household Member Who Had Turned 12 Years Old. At the Time of the Inspection, There Was One Household Member Who Had Turned 13 Years Old That Did Not Have a Background Check Submitted. This Was a Repeat Rule No (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
