Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Having Required Caregiver Training Completed. At the Time of the Inspection, One Caregiver Had Not Completed Preservice Training Offered by the Department Before Beginning Caregiving duties. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance. (1) and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Having Children Who Were Not Actively Supervised. In the Early Preschool D Class, the Caregiver Did Not Know the Number of Children in Their Care (1). None of the 2 findings were critical.
