Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Provider Was Out of Compliance with Rule R381-100-10(3) by Not Ensuring That There Were at Least Two Caregivers if a Group of Children Had More Than Two Children Who Were Younger Than 18 Months of Age and Had More Than Four Children in a Mixed Age Group That Included Any Infant or Toddler. In Th (1) and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Ensuring That Caregivers Provided and Maintained Active Supervision of Each Child, Including the Caregivers Knowing the Number of Children in Their Care at Any Time. In the Preschool Classroom, the Caregiver Did Not Know the Number of Children (1). None of the 2 findings were critical.
