In the Infants Room, There Was One Caregiver with One Infant and Five Young and Older Toddlers. (2), The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Allowing Individuals to Be Involved in Caregiving Duties Before Receiving Notification From Child Care Licensing. In the Facility, an Individual Was Involved in Childcare Before Getting Notification of Clearance by CCL. (1), and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Ensuring That There Was a Director Designee with Authority to Act on Behalf of the Director's Absence. At the Time of the Inspection, the Director Was Not Present and There Was Not a Director Designee. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
