In the Toddler A Room, There Were Several Sippy Cups That Were Not Labeled. This Is a Repeat Rule Noncompliance as N (1), The Provider Was Out of Compliance with R381-100-14(6) by Not Ensuring That Drills for Disasters, Other Than Fires, Were Completed at Least Once Every Six Months. At the Time of the Inspection, Documentation on Site Showed That the Last Disaster Drill Was Conducted in November of 2024. This Is a Rep (1), and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with R381-100-7(9)(b) by Not Ensuring That All Caregivers Completed the Preservice Training Offered by the Department Before Becoming Involved with Child Care. At the Time of the Inspection, One Caregiver Had Not Completed the Required Training. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
