Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Documenting Each Toddler's Diaper Changes Within an Hour. In the Toddler Room, a Diaper Change From the Previous Day Had Not Been Recorded Within an Hour for One Toddler. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance. (2), The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Labeling Medications Supplied by Parents with the Child's Name. In the Kitchen, There Was a Bottle of Over-the-counter Medication That Had Not Been Labeled with Any Child's Name, and the Director Did Not Know Who It Belonged To. This Was a Rep (1), and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Ensuring That Hazardous Chemicals Were Inaccessible to Children. In the Infant/toddler Room, There Was a Bottle of Dawn Dish Detergent on the Top of the Sink Area, Accessible to Children. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
