Across 2 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-13(4) by Having Choking Hazards Accessible to Children Younger Than Three Years Old. In the Outdoor Play Area, There Were Several Small Broken Pieces of Plastic Throughout the Playground. (3), The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-6(9) by Not Ensuring That a Parent Completes an Admission and Health Assessment Form for Their Child Before the Child Is Admitted Into the Child Care Program. At the Time of Inspection There Were Three Children in Care That Did Not Have an Admission Fo (1), and The Licensee Was Out of Compliance with R430-90-8(13) by Not Ensuring to Notify OBP Within 48 Hours of Becoming Aware of a Covered Individual's Arrest Warrant, Felony or Misdemeanor Arrest, Charge, Conviction, or LIS Supported Finding. On January 9, 2026, the Licensor Received a Rapback Notification (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
