Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were The Provider Was Out of Compliance with Rule R381-100-11(1)(a) by Not Ensuring That Caregivers Provide and Maintain Active Supervision by Being Physically Present in the Room with Children Younger Than Five Years Old. In the Napping Room, There Were Two Infants Sleeping with No Caregivers Present In (1) and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with Rule R381-100-9(12)(a) by Not Ensuring That Rooms Where Infants and Toddlers Are Cared for Have One Sink Used Exclusively for the Preparation of Food and Bottles and Handwashing Before Food Preparation, and Another Sink That Is Used Only for Handwashing After (1). None of the 2 findings were critical.
