Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were 0146(1)(a)(b): At Time of Visit, There Was Insufficient Ground Cover Under Slides. Wood Chip Depth Measured 3 Inches and Less on Various Playgrounds. Sufficient Wood Chips Are on Playgrounds; Wood Chips Need to Be Spread Out and Maintained to Ensure Depth of at Least 9 Inches Under and Arounds Slides and Climbing Structures. (1), 0260(1)(a): Disinfectant Bottles Were Stored in Unlocked Cupboards Making Them Accessible to Children. (1), and 0345(5)(b): Multiple Doors Did Not Have Working Chimes/bells to Alert When the Door Is Opened. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
