Risk (1), (1)(a) There Were 3-step Bottles in a Bin That Was Accessible to the Children in the Back Room with the Back Door That Leads to the Outdoor Play Area. Risk (1), and (4)(d) The Emergency Drill Form Had Little to No Notes of How the Drills Went and How They May Be Improved. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
