● 30 Important

Across 5 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Medication Administration - Parent Authorization (10), Potential Source Of Harm On Premises (9), and Department Notices Posted (4). None of the 30 findings were critical.

● **Department Notices Posted**

The Notice of Order, Sanctions and Appeal Process issued on 05/29/25 was not posted next to the child care license.

● **Person In Sole Charge Of Children - Minimum Age**

251.055(1)(i)

Staff A is under the age of 18 years old and was left in sole charge of a group of children in Room 6.

● **Medication Administration - Parent Authorization**

251.07(6)(f)1.a.

One parent authorization was approved for a period of 2 years in Room 4a.

● **Medication Administration - As Labeled & Authorized**

251.07(6)(f)5.

Two medications in Room 4a were not being administered per labeled instruction.

● **Current Authorizations For Medications On Premises**

251.07(6)(f)6.

One parent authorization to administer was expired in Room 4a.

● **Washing Child's Hands & Face**

251.07(6)(i)1.

A child in Room 2 did not have their hands washed after getting their diaper changed.

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● **Adult Handwashing**

Staff in Room 2 did not wash their hands before changing diapers.

● **Infant & Toddler - Soft Materials In Cribs**

A 4 month old infant was sleeping in a swing with a blanket.

● **Infant & Toddler - Sleep Position**

A 4 month old infant was sleeping in a swing.

● **Infant & Toddler - Food & Formula Brought From Home**

The bottles in the refrigerator of Room 2 were not labeled with child's name and date.

A self-reported incident occurred on 09/19/25 when child injury resulted in a medical evaluation. The child care center

The Warning Letter of Noncompliance issued on 08/26/24 was not posted by the child care license.

● **Child Abuse & Neglect - Biennial Training**

251.05(3)(cm)

The Child Abuse and Neglect training for Staff A and B had expired.

● **Potential Source Of Harm On Premises**

251.06(2)(a)

Black mold was observed growing from under the carpet and onto the wall in the food storage room due to a water leak.

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● **Premises - Well Drained, Clean, In Good Repair**

Per observation and staff interview, water has been leaking into the basement storage areas for approximately two years.

● **Deteriorating Paint**

251.06(2)(i)

Several classrooms contained deteriorating paint in areas accessible to children.

● **Windows & Doors Used For Ventilation**

The window in Room 4 did not contain a screen was open.

● **Food Storage - Food Not Requiring Refrigeration**

Due to a water leak in the wall the food storage room had a wet carpet, smelled musty, and had mold growing from under t

● **Food Storage - Dry Food**

251.06(9)(d)2.a.

Dry food items were not stored in bags with zip-type closures or metal, glass or food grade plastic containers with tigh

● **Time Out - Not Removed From Classroom**

251.07(2)(c)5.

Per staff interview, children are removed from the classroom for longer than three minutes for their behaviors. At times

● **Medication Administration - Parent Authorization**

251.07(6)(f)1.a.

In Room 3 two medications did not have a parent authorization to administer.

● **Medication Administration - Containers & Labeling**

251.07(6)(f)1.b.

In Room 4 two medications were not labeled with the child's name.

● **Medication Administration - As Labeled & Authorized**

251.07(6)(f)5.

In Room 3 one medication was not being administered as authorized by parents.

● **Current Authorizations For Medications On Premises**

251.07(6)(f)6.

In Room 3 the parent authorization to administer was expired for one medication.

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● **Infant & Toddler - Diaper Changing Surface Disinfection**

251.09(4)(a)3.

In Room 2 the diaper changing mat was ripped and falling apart. The surface was not easily cleanable.

● **Report - Incident Or Accident**

251.04(3)(a)

The center failed to report an incident occurred on 8/28/2024 where a child required professional medical evaluation.

Aug 20, 2024 3 Findings ● 3 Important

● **Deteriorating Paint**

251.06(2)(i)

There is flaking and deteriorating paint on both decks and railings, as well as the climber in the outdoor space.

● **Emergencies - Practice Written Plans**

251.06(3)(b)2.

The center did not have documentation of monthly fire evacuation and tornado drills for May, June or July.

● **Fire Alarms & Smoke Detectors - Testing**

251.06(4)(jm)2.

The center did not have documentation that the fire detection and alarms had been tested for June and July.

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
