An emergency contact, other than the parents, was not on file for 4 of the 5 children's files reviewed.

● **Child Record - Enrollment Information - Medical Contact**

The name, address, and telephone number of the child's physician or medical facility caring for the child was missing fo

● **Child Record - Enrollment Information - Authorized Pickup**

● **Child Record - Enrollment Information - Date Of Attendance**

● **Staff File - Physical Examination - Form**

A physical that indicates a the person is able to work with children and free from illness was not on file for Staff A.

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● **Continuing Education - Requirement & Training Topics**

Staff A did not have documentation of completed 15 hours of continuing education for the 2024 years.

● **Access To Materials Potentially Harmful To Children**

Various cleaning/sanitizing items labeled "keep out of reach of children" were observed accessible to children.

● **Premises - Condition & Repair**

The outdoor play space was observed with litter. There were small bits of garbage, a broken piece of fence and dried pet

The smoke detector was not installed and properly operating. The smoke detector was not hung on the wall and there was n

Documentation of the annual fire extinguisher inspection was not on file for the 2024 year.

The freezer was not observed clean.

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
