The Toddler Room's attendance was not current and accurate when five children were in care and six were signed in on the

● **Continuing Education Requirement - Full Time Staff**

Documentation of staff obtaining 15 hours of continuing education was not available for review for Staff A, B, G, and J.

● **Child Tracking Procedure**

The center did not implement the child tracking procedure when children were moved between the infant and toddler rooms

● **Staff-To-Child Ratios - Children Of Staff**

Staff-to-child ratios were not maintained in the Preschool and School-Age Classrooms where children from both rooms were

● **Toilets & Washbasins - Use Of Steps Or Blocks**
