● **Staff Record - Physical Examination**

Staff A, D, and E do not have a health report on file.

● **Staff Record - Registry Certificate**

251.05(2)(a)4.a.

Staff A has been working at the center for more than 6 months and does not have a registry certificate on file showing s

● **Staff Record - Educational Qualifications**

251.05(2)(a)4.d.

Staff A and B do not have documentation that they meet the educational qualifications for their positions.

● **Abusive Head Trauma Prevention Training**

Staff B does not have documentation of completing the Abusive Head Trauma training.

● **Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Training**

Staff F does not have a current CPR certificate on file.

● **Medication Administration - As Labeled & Authorized**

There was an expired medication for a child in the Nature Scouts classroom.

There was no medication authorization form filled out, signed or dated by a parent for a medication that was at the cent

● **Washing Child's Hands & Face**

Children in the infant room did not have their hands washed with soap and water or a wet cloth after diaper changes.

● **Infant & Toddler - Sleep Position**

Per observation, a child under the age of 1 was asleep in a bouncer seat for at least 15 minutes.

● **Infant & Toddler - Food & Formula Brought From Home**

Bottles in the refrigerator were not labeled with the child's name or dated.

● **Mixed-Age Group - Staff-To-Child Ratio**

● **Medical Log - Medical Evaluation**

● **Prohibited Actions - Verbal**

251.07(2)(e)2.

Staff admitted to raising their voice at children when frustrated with behaviors.

● **Washing Child's Hands & Face**

251.07(6)(i)1.

Children in the Bears room did not wash their hands after diaper changes.

● **Infant & Toddler - Crib Mattresses & Coverings**

251.09(1)(j)

Per observation, multiple cribs in the infant room did not have tight fitting sheets on the mattresses.

● **Infant & Toddler - Diaper Changing Surface Disinfection**

The diaper changing surface was not cleaned with soap and water or disinfected after use.

Staff A has not completed the required 4 hours of training in kitchen sanitation, food handling, and nutrition.

● **Supervision Of Children**

A child was not supervised when a staff member fell asleep during nap time and a child left the classroom and was found

● **Safe Food**

The center has multiple items on site including hard boiled eggs, cottage cheese, margarine/butter, Go Go Squeeze yogurt

● **Canned Food**

One large can of pudding and one large can of fruit were dented.

● **Infant & Toddler - Documenting Changes In Development**
