There were several prickly weeds in the outdoor play space that were accessible to children.

There were outlets in the Infant room and Yellow room that were not protected with a guard.

During the licensing visit, the driver was signed in but was not present.

There was no documentation of an orientation completion for Staff A or Staff B.

● **Child Abuse & Neglect - Biennial Training**

The Child Abuse & Neglect training on file for Staff A expired in November 2024.
