Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Deteriorating Paint (7), Naps Or Rest Periods - Sleeping Surfaces - Children Under 1 (6), and Infant & Toddler - Diaper Changing Surface Disinfection (5). None of the 30 findings were critical.

● **Potential Source Of Harm On Premises**

The Ocean room was not free of potential source of harm when carpets had roll/fold edges on multiple areas posing a pote

● **Electrical Or Hot Surface Protection**

Electric outlets at the Ocean and Butterfly rooms, accessible to children, were not protected by screens or guards.

● **Group Size - Maximum**
