● 30 Important

Across 7 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Potential Source Of Harm On Premises (12), Daily Outdoor Activities (7), and Staff Record - Completed Background Check (5). None of the 30 findings were critical.

● **Potential Source Of Harm On Premises**

Broken mirror on changing table of room 105 had sharp glass edges accessible to toddlers in care

● **Indoor Space - Square Footage Per Child**

36 children were in care in room 102. The room lacked 35 square feet per child required

● **Dishwashing - Air Drying**

Dishes being air dried with baskets, racks or boards as required

● **Food Storage - Refrigeration Units**

Center refrigerator measured at 43 degrees, exceeding required temperatures

Staff observed on camera leaving classroom with infant children outside of sight and sound repeatedly

Staff acting contrary to guidance policy using cellphone rather than engaging with and supervising children.

Multiple infants observed left for extended periods of time restrained without programming or interaction in high chairs
