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● **Potential Source Of Harm On Premises**

Every classroom has lose cords accessible to children which is a strangulation hazard. The cords are from smart board,

● **Electrical Or Hot Surface Protection**

Several classrooms have fans accessible to children which are not protected by a screen.

● **Access To Materials Potentially Harmful To Children**

On the front desk of the main entry there is a container of disinfectant wipes and a bottle of Bactine.

● **Emergencies - Practice Written Plans**

There was no documentation of a fire drill in April.
