● **Mixed Age Group With Children Under Age 2 - Group Size**

● **Abusive Head Trauma Prevention Training**

Staff A did not have abusive head trauma prevention training on file prior to beginning work with children under 5 years

● **Child Abuse & Neglect - Biennial Training**

Staff A did not have documentation of current child abuse and neglect training on file.

● **Access To Materials Potentially Harmful To Children**

Air Wick air fresheners labeled 'keep out of reach of children' were stored in an unlocked cabinet under the sink in the

● **Dishwashing - Air Drying**

● **Home-Canned / Processed Food**

The pantry had three unlabeled jars of what appeared to be preserves.

● **Food Storage - Cold Storage Thermometers**

The mini fridge in the lobby area had bottles of breastmilk, but no thermometer.

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● **Equipment - Quantity For Indoors**

Due to construction, toys from the middle classroom were packed away in a trailer in December not allowing each child a

● **Medical Log - Injury In Care**

Child care workers are documenting injuries received by children while in the care of the center in Brightwheel rather t

● **Infant & Toddler - Documenting Changes In Development**

251.09(1)(c)

Four out of six Intake Under 2 forms were not updated every three months.

● **Infant & Toddler - Crib Mattresses & Coverings**

251.09(1)(j)

Cribs and playpens did not have a mattress covering that fits snugly over the mattress.

● **Infant & Toddler - Responding To Crying Children**

Child care workers did not respond promptly to a crying child's needs when they were observed each holding a child while

● **Staff Record - Educational Qualifications**
