● **Child Record - Enrollment Information**

251.04(6)(a)1.

The enrollment form for Child 2, Child 3, and Child 4 lacked emergency contact information when a parent cannot be reach

● **Child Record - Emergency Medical Consent**

251.04(6)(a)2.

Written consent from the parent for emergency medical care or treatment is not on file for Child 3.

● **Child Record - Field Trip Authorization**

251.04(6)(a)4.

Authorization from the parent for Child 3 to participate in field trips and other off-premises activities is not on file

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● **Child Record - Immunization History**

251.04(6)(a)6m.

Child 3 and Child 4 do not have immunization history on file and have been attending the center for more than 30 days.

● **Staff Record - Personal Information**

Staff C does not have staff information on file, including emergency contact information.

● **Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Training**

● **Meal Prep Personnel - Training**

Staff C, identified as the meal service personnel, did not have documentation of completing at least 4 hours of training

A baby bouncer seat, observed in the infant room, had a tear causing the stuffing to be exposed and the seat not easily

● **Medical Log - Medication Administration**

A child care worker shall record in the medical log book any medication dispensed to a child, on the date the medication

● **Medical Log - Reviewing Injury Records**

There is no documentation that the medical log book in the 2 year old and infant room was reviewed within the last 6 mon

● **Medication Administration - As Labeled & Authorized**

A child's medication (Amphetamine) was given to the child on 9/30/24, 10/1/24, 10/7/24, 10/8/24, and 10/15/24. The author

● **Current Authorizations For Medications On Premises**

251.07(6)(f)6.

A child's medication (Amphetamine) observed on the premise lacked a current authorization form; the form expired 9/26/24

● **Infant & Toddler - Food & Formula Brought From Home**

In the infant room, a container of Puffs and package of Fruit and Veggie Melts were open and exceeded the suggested use

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
