● **Child Record - Health History**

250.04(6)(a)1m.

During a child record review, it was found that 2 children were missing health history documentation.

● **Child Record - Physical Exam - Under 2**

250.04(6)(a)4.a.

During a child record review, it was found that two children, under the age of 2 years, were missing a health report.

● **Child Record - Physical Exam - Over 2, Under 5**

During a child record review, one child (over 2 yrs) was missing a health report from his/her file.

The exit considered the center's 'secondary exit' was partially blocked by a couple chair pillows and a baby 'exercise-t

Jul 16, 2024 3 Findings ● 3 Important

● **Emergency Plans - Practice**

250.06(3)(b)

Documentation showed only 1 drill has been practiced since original licensing. Fire drills must be completed once per m

● **Smoke Detectors - Testing**

250.06(4)(a)3.

The provider didn't have documentation showing that smoke detectors are checked monthly.

● **Exits - Unobstructed**

250.06(7)(a)1.

During this monitoring visit, one exit door at the front off the house was obstructed by 3 chairs.

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
