Across 5 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 251.04(4)(a)2.c. (10), Parent Notification - Injury, Consumption Of Allergen, Incor (5), and Access To Materials Potentially Harmful To Children (5). None of the 30 findings were critical.

● **Parent Notification - Injury, Consumption Of Allergen, Incor**

Per staff interview and review of documentation, parent are not immediately notified of head injuries in the 2K Classroom

● **Child Record - Immunization History**

Child 1 did not have record of immunizations on file.

● **Group Size & Ratio - Field Trips, Outdoor Play Areas**

Staff-to-child ratios were not maintained for the 2K Classroom when 14 children were playing outside with 1 staff.

● **Access To Materials Potentially Harmful To Children**

A staff members bag was open and located on low shelf in the Infant Green Classroom cubby area. Prescription medication

● **Exits & Passageways - Unobstructed, Minimum Width**

The window cranks were missing from the emergency exit windows in the School-age Classroom.
