Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Exit Lights (11), Staff Record - Completed Background Check (10), and Child Record - Physical Exam - Under 2 (3). None of the 30 findings were critical.

Child #1 did not have an updated physical examination at least once every 6 months after the initial examination.

● **Current, Accurate Daily Attendance Record**

The attendance was not accurate as one child was not signed in as present in the Zoe room.

● **Staff Record - Completed Background Check**

Staff F and G did not have documentation, either electronic or paper, of completing a caregiver background check prior t

● **Staff Record - Physical Examination**

Staff F did not have documentation of a physical examination within 30 days of employment at the center.

Staff F did not have documentation of educational qualifications.

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● **Current Authorizations For Medications On Premises**

An epi pen was present at the center for a child, however, there was no documentation of parental permission to administ

● **Infant & Toddler - Food & Formula Brought From Home**

Pre-made bottles brought from home were not dated and one bottle in teh refriggerator was observed without a name.

● **Infant & Toddler - Sinks In Self-Contained Area**

The hand washing sink was being used for rinsing bottles.

● **Electrical Or Hot Surface Protection**

Power bar with uncovered electrical outlets accessible to children in the Bert classroom

● **Cleaning Aids - Equipment**

251.06(2)(m)

Mop with partially full built in chemical storage tank stored accessible to children in the Bert classroom

● **Food Storage - Cold Storage Thermometers**

251.06(9)(d)1.c.

No properly working thermometer in center freezer

● **Food Storage - Dry Food**

251.06(9)(d)2.a.

Flour stored open in original packaging and not in food safe plastic or zip style bags

● **Infant & Toddler - Sinks In Self-Contained Area**

Dirty dishes left in infant room hand washing sink

● **Child Record - Health History**

251.04(6)(a)6.

Child #2 lacked complete health history information

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● **Staff Record - Registry Certificate**

251.05(2)(a)4.a.

Staff file reviewed did not include the required Registry certificate

● **Access To Materials Potentially Harmful To Children**

251.06(2)(d)

Shaving cream in the Elmo labeled keep out of reach of children stored on a low shelf in an unsecured cabinet

● **Deteriorating Paint**

251.06(2)(i)

Flaking paint accessible to children on lower blue walls of infant classroom

● **Emergencies - Practice Written Plans**

251.06(3)(b)2.

No practice of emergency plans documented in January of 2025

● **Exit Lights**

251.06(4)(i)

Exit light to outdoor play area not lit as required by rule. Exit light in Bert room also not working

● **Food Storage - Cold Storage Thermometers**

No clearly visible thermometer found in center freezer

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
