There was no documentation showing that a fire drill was practiced for the months of January and February 2026. Rule req

● Smoke Detectors - Testing

There was no documentation showing that smoke detectors were tested for January and February 2026. Rule requires a recor

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● **Infant & Toddler - Audio Monitoring**

250.09(1)(c)4g.

Rules requires an audio monitoring device be used in any room where children under the age of one year are placed to sle

● **Infant & Toddler - Food & Formula Brought From Home**
