● **Procedure - Number, Names, Whereabouts Known At All Times**

The licensee did not implement and adhere to a procedure to ensure the number, names, and whereabouts of children in car

● **Electrical Or Hot Surface Protection**

Three electric outlets were uncovered and not protected so that children cannot touch them.
