● **Report - Prohibited Actions**

The licensee did not report to the Department within 24 hours after an incident wherein an employee used prohibited actions

● **Parent Notification - Inappropriate Child Guidance**

Parents were not consistently notified when their child(ren) were subject to inappropriate child guidance and/or prohibited actions

● **Staff Record - Days & Hours Worked**

● **Infant & Toddler - Self Feeding**

On 09/26/25, cups used by children in the Infant 3 Room were not scaled to the size and developmental level of the child

● **Current, Accurate Daily Attendance Record**

251.04(6)(b)

The attendance was not current and accurate in the Preschool 1 Room when 16 children were signed in on the attendance record

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● **Pets & Animals - Notification**

251.07(7)(c)

The licensee did not ensure that parents were aware of the occasional presence of a pet dog at the center, that was kept

● **Current, Accurate Daily Attendance Record**

The attendance was not current and accurate in the Toddler 1 Room.

● **Stairs, Walks, Ramps, Porches - Safety**

Sidewalks and ramps outside the classroom exits were not free of the accumulation of snow.

Lines were skipped between entries in the medical log book, which is prohibited.

● **Child Record - Emergency Medical Consent**

Child # 3's record was missing written consent from the parent for emergency medical care or treatment.

● **Staff Record - Physical Examination**
