● 30 Important

Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Outdoor Play Space - Energy-Absorbing Surfaces (8), Naps Or Rest Periods - Bedding Maintenance, Storage, Cleanli (8), and Infant & Toddler - Documenting Changes In Development (7). None of the 30 findings were critical.

● Report - Damage To Premises

Licensee failed to report damages to the Department within 24 hours after the occurrence. Damages resulted in the need

● Child Record - Enrollment Information

251.04(6)(a)1.

Enrollment information was incomplete for Child 2, Child 3, Child 4, and Child 6. Forms lacked addresses, while the chil

● Child Record - Health History

251.04(6)(a)6.

The file for Child 2 lacked a health history form upon licensing review.

● Outdoor Play Space - Energy-Absorbing Surfaces

251.06(11)(b)5.

The outdoor play space lacked sufficient energy-absorbing materials, in a depth of at least nine inches under climbing e

● Outdoor Play Space - Enclosure

251.06(11)(b)7.

The outdoor play space lacked a permanent enclosure without open areas greater than 4 inches. Large gaps were observed b

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● **Potential Source Of Harm On Premises**

251.06(2)(a)

The premise was not free from potential sources of harm at the time of licensing visit. Loose ground covering was obser

● **Access To Materials Potentially Harmful To Children**

251.06(2)(d)

Materials potentially harmful were accessible to children in the infant room throughout licensing visit. A cabinet cont

● **Premises - Well Drained, Clean, In Good Repair**

251.06(2)(gm)

The premise was not maintained in good repair at the time of licensing visit. Broken radiators were observed throughout

● **Deteriorating Paint**

251.06(2)(i)

The premise was not free from flaking and deteriorating paint upon licensing visit. Paint was observed flaking on vario

● **Emergencies - Record Of Fire / Tornado Drills**

251.06(3)(b)4.

Center lacked documentation of fire and tornado drills being practiced. The last documented drill was January 2026.

● **Fire Alarms & Smoke Detectors - Testing**

Center lacked documentation of detectors and alarm systems being tested monthly since February 2026.

● **Naps Or Rest Periods - Bedding Maintenance, Storage, Cleanli**

Bedding was not stored in a clean and sanitary manner. Nap mats and cots were located in the classrooms in an open area

● **Meals & Snacks - Minimum Meal Requirements**

Lunch, served to children at the time of licensing visit, failed to meet USDA minimum meal requirements. Children were s

● **Menus - Post**

No menus were posted at the center at the time of licensing visit.

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● **Medical Log - Reviewing Injury Records**

The medical log book in the 2-3 year old room lacked documentation of a review within the past 6 months. The last docum

● **Washing Child's Hands & Face**

Children s hands were not washed after being diapered or before eating lunch.

● **Adult Handwashing**

Staff in the infant room did not wash their hands after diapering children.

● **Infant & Toddler - Documenting Changes In Development**

Changes in a child s development and routines were not documented every three months in the infant/toddler room. Forms

● **Infant & Toddler - Soft Materials In Cribs**

Children in the infant room, under the age of one, were observed sleeping in cribs with soft, loose materials upon licen

● **Infant & Toddler - Care During Feeding**

251.09(3)(a)11.

Children in the infant room were not secured in high chairs with provided safety straps. Buckles/safety straps were onl

● **Infant & Toddler - Bottle Feeding**

251.09(3)(a)9.

A child was observed with a bottle propped on a blanket, in a crib upon licensing arrival. Blanket and bottle were remov

● **Infant & Toddler - Diaper Changing Surface Disinfection**

251.09(4)(a)3.

Children in the infant room were not changed on an easily cleanable surface at the time of licensing visit. Center was u

● **Child Record - Physical Exam - Under 2**

251.04(6)(a)8.a.

The file for Child 4 lacked an updated physical examination upon licensing review. The last documented examination was

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● **Current, Accurate Daily Attendance Record**

251.04(6)(b)

Attendance records were not maintained current and accurate upon licensing review. Multiple children were not signed ou

● **Meal Prep Personnel - Training**

251.05(3)(gr)3.a.

Staff, who are stated to make snacks and meals, lacked documentation of 4 hours in meal prep personnel training original

● **Mixed Age Group With Children Under Age 2 - Group Size**

251.055(2)(d)

Center failed to maintain group sizes when utilizing a mixed age group with children under the age of two. 13 children

● **Medical Log - Pages & Entries**

251.07(6)(dm)2.

Medical log books, throughout the facility, contained skipped lines and blank pages.

● **Medical Log - Reviewing Injury Records**

251.07(6)(dm)4.

Center medical log books lacked documentation of a review being conducted at least every six (6) months, to ensure that

● **Infant & Toddler - Intake Information**

Prior to admission, the center failed to obtain written information for Child 3, to individualize the program of care fo

● **Infant & Toddler - Documenting Changes In Development**

Child care staff failed to document changes in Child 4 s development and routines, every three months based on discussio

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
