● 30 Important

Across 6 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Child Record - Emergency Medical Consent (7), Child Tracking Procedure (6), and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Training (5). None of the 30 findings were critical.

● **Child Record - Emergency Medical Consent**

Child #1 did not have documentation of emergency medical care.

● **Child Record - Field Trip Authorization**

Child #1 did not acknowledge field trip section of enrollment form.

● **Current, Accurate Daily Attendance Record**

The attendance records in the 2 year old classroom on the 2nd floor were not accurate. The 5 children in the classroom

● **Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Training**

Staff C and staff F did not have documentation of current CPR on file.

● **Continuing Education Requirement - Full Time Staff**

Staff F did not have documentation of 15 hours of continuing education on file.

● **Child Tracking Procedure**

There were 5 children in the 1 year old room but six children were on the tracking sheet. There were 6 children in the t

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● **Access To Materials Potentially Harmful To Children**

There were cleaning supplies in the vanity of the two year old bathroom that were accessible to children.

● **Food Storage - Cold Storage Thermometers**

There was no thermometer in the kitchen refrigerator.

● **Menus - Post**

There was no menu posted in the kitchen.

● **Menus - Available For Review**

The menus were not available for review.

● **Infant & Toddler - Location & Sharing Intake Information**

The toddler room did not have the intake under two forms in the classroom.

● **Staff-To-Child Ratios - Minimum**

251.055(2)(b)

There were 8 infant/toddlers in care with one teacher.

Oct 21, 2025 5 Findings ● 5 Important

● **Daily Attendance Record - Transportation**

251.04(6)(c)

The vehicle attendance records did not have sign out times for children.

● **Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Training**

251.05(3)(c)

Staff A does not have current CPR training on file.

● **Child Abuse & Neglect - Biennial Training**

251.05(3)(cm)

Staff A does not have current Child Abuse and Neglect training on file.

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● **Driver Record - Obtain & Review**

251.08(4)(c)1.

Staff A did not have a current driver record on file.

● **Vehicle Inspection Report**

251.08(5)(b)

The most current vehicle inspection report is expired.

Jul 28, 2025 2 Findings ● 2 Important

● **Licensed Capacity**

251.04(1)(a)

There were 36 children in care during the site visit completed July 28, 2025.

● **Mixed Age Group Of Children Over Age 2 - Group Size**

There were 12 mixed age (2-4 years) children being cared for by 1 teacher.

● **Child Record - Physical Exam - Under 2**

251.04(6)(a)8.a.

Child #2 did not have a current health report on file.

● **Child Record - Physical Exam - Over 2, Under 5**

251.04(6)(a)8.b.

Child #1,3, and 4. Did not have a current health report on file.

● **Child Abuse & Neglect - Biennial Training**

251.05(3)(cm)

Staff A, C, and D did not have documentation of current Child Abuse and Neglect training in staff file.

● **Child Tracking Procedure**

There were twelve children combined for napping but there were only 9 children signed in.

● **Safe Food**

There was infant cereal that did not have an open date to ensure that it dose not expire. There was uncovered leftover f

● **Child Tracking Procedure**

251.055(1)(f)

There were 5 children in the infant room but only 4 children were tracked on the tracking sheet.

● **Staff-To-Child Ratios - Minimum**

251.055(2)(b)

There were 5 children in the infant room with 1 teacher.

● **Fire Alarms & Smoke Detectors - Maintenance**

251.06(4)(j)2.

The smoke detector in the infant room was chirping and not in good working order.

● **Medical Log - Reviewing Injury Records**

251.07(6)(dm)4.

The medical log book was not reviewed every six months as required.

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● Medication Administration - Parent Authorization

251.07(6)(f)1.a.

The medication authorization for three children was not completed thoroughly. The dates of medical administration were

There was medication on site that did not have an authorization.

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
